

# Provisional Voter

A Provisional ballot is given to a voter only if the issue cannot be resolved by the Registrars within a few minutes.

Please do not give a Provisional ballot to a voter without first checking with the Registrars.

## Who gets a Provisional ballot?

- A voter whose name cannot be found on the voting list
- A voter who is listed in the wrong party
- A voter who cannot provide an ID at the polls.

## What if a Provisional voter is unable to present an ID at the polls?

- A voter has until the close of polls (8PM) to present an acceptable form of ID to the Registrars of Voters or the City Clerk in City Hall.

## Procedure for Provisional voting

- Provide the voter with the following:
  - Notice to voters
  - Provisional ballot information sheet
  - Provisional ballot affirmation
  - Provisional voting roster
  - Ballot marked "Provisional"
  - Provisional ballot envelope
- Voter must present an acceptable ID which is noted on the Provisional ballot affirmation.
- Voter must vote the ballot, seal it in the Provisional ballot envelope, and present it to the Election Worker.
- Election Worker provides a receipt to the voter.
- Election Worker places all Provisional ballots in a separate envelope.
